I am requesting funding for A New Pathway – The Central Maryland Aviation Maintenance Workforce Initiative in Fiscal Year 2027. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Community College of Baltimore County, the project is located at 701 Wilson Point Rd, Middle River, MD 21220.

Funds will be used for an Aviation Maintenance Technology program that will train students for FAA Airframe and Powerplant certification through a 1,650-hour curriculum. The program will address regional workforce shortages in aviation maintenance, strengthen Maryland's aviation and aerospace sectors, and create accessible pathways to high-wage technical careers supporting economic growth and infrastructure reliability.

The project is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it will address critical workforce shortages among tradespeople. It will increase economic development.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for purposes authorized in 49 U.S.C. 47100 et seq.
